Recent Chapman pro bono efforts have resulted in Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) granting parole to two women, both victims of torture for their involvement in the Anglophone separatist movement in Cameroon. Both women will be released from immigration detention to be with family and friends while they await hearings before the immigration court.
